- Furnaces and water heaters that won't back-draft exhaust fumes, resulting in better indoor air quality.
- Radon resistant construction (in high risk zones) to vent dangerous soil gases.
- Fresh air systems that replace 100% of the air in your home at least three times each day alongside advanced technology filtration that removes airborne particles associated with common respiratory problems.

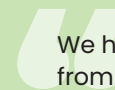
Health and Comfort

- Low energy bills!

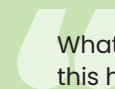

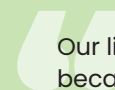

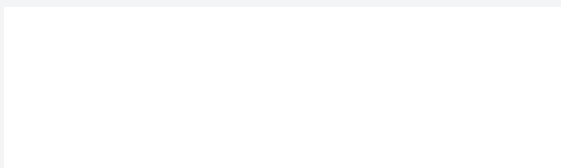
